This week we have been learning...

This week, in our writing, we have continued to look at our book 'Ice Trap!' We have been able to sequence the story and write about what happened in our own words. We have used a variety of conjunctions and adjectives in our writing. We have learnt about different sentence types in order to prepare ourselves for writing non-chronological reports. We have located the features of reports and begun to plan a report all about Ernest Shackleton. We have used a range of resources to find information to put into our reports.

In Maths, we have continued to investigate money. We have been able to select money for different purposes. We have also been able to make the same total using a variety of coins and notes. We have been able to solve two step word problems using RUCSAC.

This week for our topic sessions we have been looking at our science. We have investigated what materials are and what they can be used for.
