This week we have been learning...

In English this week we have been learning about 'The Lonely Beast'. We have been using apostrophes for possession. We have been able to write a character description of the beast. We have been able to plan and write the story of the Lonely Beast using a variety of punctuation and adjectives.

In maths we have investigated fractions. We have been able to find, half, quarters and thirds of different shapes. We can explain what the numerator and denominator represents in a fraction. We have been able to explain our answers and use a variety of ways to prove if something is correct or incorrect.

This week in topic we have learnt about fairies. We received a letter from Fabio the class fairy asking us lots of questions, so we wrote back to Fabio answering his questions and asking some of our own. We have written a descriptive piece to describe a fairy and written about freeze frames that we have created. We have been able to use a variety of materials and equipment to plan, make and evaluate our own fairy houses.
