## This week we have been learning...

This week in our writing we have written about what we would do if we became mayor for the day. We have thought hard about why the public should vote for us. This week we have had an incident in the classroom, where it has been messed up and clues left behind. We have made wanted posters for the culprit and written them a letter to ask why they have done this. We have been able to use our previous knowledge of adjectives to help us.

In maths we have continued to apply our knowledge of the 3 times table using coins. We have used the bar model to show our understanding of fact families. We have begun to look at addition and how to solve sums using resources. We have been able to use number lines, hundred squares, bead strings, counters and cubes. We have begun to show our workings out using a number line to count the number of jumps.
