Throughout this week, we have focused on developing our understanding of the way in which speech is punctuated to allow us to include this within our new stories. In Maths, we have been solving a range of division and multiplication problems. Fortune have been focusing upon using known facts to help them solve trickier two digit multiplication and division problems. We have learnt about where cocoa grows and the processes the bean goes through before arriving in stores all over the world. The class have used digital mapping and atlases to help them successfully locate different cocoa growing regions all around the world.
