This week we have been learning about ...

In English, we have been writing our own fantastic non-chronological reports based around replica Stone Age items. We have made sure that we have included a range of conjunctions in our work alongside lots of other key pieces of punctuation. We have made sure that we have included a wide range of skills in our writing that we have been learning about so far this term.

In Maths, have been focusing upon our understanding of subtraction this week. We have been moving towards using a formal column method for subtraction whilst continuing to develop our understanding of place value. We have been learning to use RUCSAC to help us understand how to answer worded questions. Fortune have used what is in their RUCSAC to help them solve lots of challenging questions.

In our afternoon topic sessions, we have been learning about Stone Age clothing. We have used our understanding to create our own designs for Stone Age clothes and then have used these designs to create our own Stone Age collages.
