We have had a busy week in Nursery. It is lovely to see how quickly the children have settled back into nursery life.

This week we have been learning about People Who Help Us, focusing upon Doctors, Nurses and Healthy Lifestyles.

The children have enjoyed looking after the babies, learning about their bodies and x-rays as well as learning to use numbers in their play.

Next week we will be continuing to learn about People Who Help Us focusing upon the Police.

We will be creating Police ID cards, learning to create a weaving pattern using colours associated with the police.

The children will also be learning about finger prints, creating disguises for a Police officer and making their own police officer puppet. We are also hoping to have a visit from a local Police officer and his police car during the week!

The children will also be learning about shapes around them; circles, rectangles, triangles, squares and stars.

Clothing
