We have read the Little Red Hen Story this week. We enjoyed talking about why the Little Red Hen didn't share her bread. We recorded our opinions on a tally chart and gave really good reasons for them. We have enjoyed mixing and making our own dough- it was tricky to get it just right!

We have tasted different types of bread this week and discovered that we liked some new types of bread. We have recalled and written the story and liked hearing different versions- we even sang it in a song!

We have also been investigating 3D shapes, building windmills out of them and find them in everyday objects in the environment.
