Welcome back we hope you have all had a wonderful Easter break. The children have all settled quickly back into the nursery routine.

This week as part of 'Animals' we have been learning all about farm animals. We have shared the story "What the ladybird heard?" by Julia Donaldson. As well as this we have learnt about the names for adult and baby farm animals, looked at where different farm animals live, created our own farm in our role play area as well as working on using our words to describe what the farm animals look like.

In Phonics we have been hearing for the first sound in words and thinking of other sounds we can hear in words to help us orally blend the words together. For example; c-a-t being cat. We have also been working on hearing rhyme within words.

Next week we will be sharing the story of 'Farmer Duck' and using this as a basis for our learning.
