In year 1 news this week we have...

In English we have introduced a new book called Superkid, which describes the journey of a superhero child who helps other children around him. We have used adjectives to describe specific parts of the story using punctuation and conjunctions also. We have learnt the spelling rule 's' and 'es' to make the root word plural. The children used this skill in their topic writing when describing their journey to school.

In Maths, the children have been working on counting in 2's, 5's and 10's by creating groups in these multiplies. The children have added these groups together to create simple addition sentence such as $5+5+5+5=$. The children used their knowledge to answer simple problem and reasoning questions.

In Topic this week we have been exploring our new topic of Superheroes. We discussed different heroes in our lives such as our parents, the ambulance service, the police and influential people within History such as Florence Nightingale. We used our skill of adding plural to our writing by describing our journey to school. For example 'On my journey to school, I see lots of trees'.

In Phonics we have recapped the sounds ew,ue,u_e,ir and wh. We have used these sounds to create sentences using punctuation.
