In English, we have been learning...

All about poetry. We have been working incredibly hard to use rhyme in our poems all about the Titanic disaster. Fortune have researched a range of exciting vocabulary to use in their group poems linked to the Titanic and have analysed a range of poems to help develop their understanding of rhyming patterns.

In Maths, we have continued to work on our understanding of time. The class have worked incredibly hard to calculate the duration of different events. They have shown their understanding using a range of different formats from digital and analogue to worded time problems. Fortune have shown an incredible understanding of AM and PM this week when sorting activities into different categories and have even used estimation to show their understanding of different times.

In our topic sessions, we started our week by creating a range of fantastic model villages. Unfortunately, these villages were struck by terrible natural disasters! Fortune used their empathy skills to show their understanding of how they would have felt if they were in this type of situation. The class have also been investigating who they feel is responsible for the Titanic disaster. They have created fantastic explanations for this which have been transferred into mini-broadcasts.
