In English, we have been focusing on recapping a range of Year 3 descriptive techniques. The class have also used the present perfect tense this week and have demonstrated an excellent understanding of this.

The class have demonstrated their understanding by finding these angles in the world all around them and have been using the appropriate terminology accurately.

They have designed an aid packet that could be used to help people in the aftermath of a disaster. The class have also used their understanding of basic needs to help plan, map and design a blueprint for a new town.
