In our topic, Disasters, we have been learning all about different types of disasters from natural to man-made.

In English, we have been creating our own explosive reports about volcanoes. Fortune have been working incredibly hard to research their own information to include in the reports and have shared this with others so that we have lots of information to include in our work. The class have been focusing on using the features of a non-chronological report while ensuring they use a range of interesting vocabulary and sentence openers.

In Maths, we have been looking at the properties of 3D shapes. Fortune have demonstrated a wonderful understanding of 3D shapes and have even been able to solve challenging puzzles where they have been asked to complete and fix broken nets of shapes. Fortune have also been working incredibly hard on their understanding of scales. The class have developed their understanding of how to interpret scales and have been using amazing vocabulary such as 'increments' in their verbal and written explanations.

In our topic sessions, the class have continued to build their volcanoes. We have started the papier-mâché process and our volcanoes are beginning to take shape. Fortune have created accurate cross-section diagrams of volcanoes to demonstrate their understanding of the different types of volcano we have explored.
