## Langley Park Primary Academy

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13<sup>th</sup> July 2018

Dear Parent/Carer,

On Tuesday 17<sup>th</sup> July, the children will have their last Transition Day and we would like to use this opportunity to practice where the children will be coming in and going home from in September.

All explanations are given as if you are looking at the front of the school building.

**Nursery** will enter/exit through their access door at the side of the building.

**Year R** (Currently Nursery) will enter/exit through the pedestrian gate to the left of the school and round to the two gates from the Reception Outdoor Learning Areas.

**Year 1** (Currently Year R) will enter/exit through the right hand gate at the front of the school.

**Year 2** (Currently Year 1) will enter/exit through the left hand gate at the front of the school.

**Year 3** (Currently Year 2) will come through the left hand pedestrian gate onto the back playground then enter/exit through back door – where we currently come in.

**Year 4** (Currently Year 3) will come through the left hand pedestrian gate onto the back playground then enter/exit through back door – where we currently come in.

We will still open the side gates at 8:30 and 3:30pm and the front gates will be unlocked when teachers are there, from 8:35am and 3:45pm.

We have now reinstated the '**drop off**' point. Children should be able to get out of the car on their own and go straight into school – we suggest this should be Year 2 and above in the first instance, but please be aware that the gates for Year 2 will not open until at least 8:35am and children should not be left unattended.

We please ask that parents do not use this area to park. Once we have established this as a drop off point in the morning, we will endeavour to see how we can work this for collection.

There will be staff around on Tuesday to point you in the right direction.

During Open Afternoon on Monday you will have the ability to look around the new classrooms and see where your children will be in September. We're looking forward to showing off all the hard work of Baxall's and the teachers.
