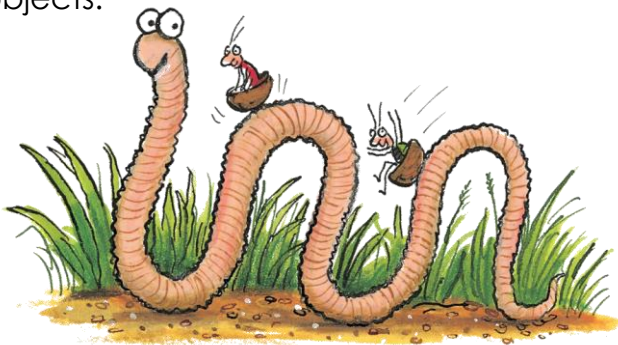
Wow what a busy week we have had!
