In our topic, This Is Me, we have been learning all about ourselves and our hopes and dreams.

In English, we have been focusing on our descriptive writing techniques. Fortune have been challenged with describing an incredible short movie called 'Rooted'. The class have made sure they have used a range of incredible techniques such as adjectives and adverbs to make their writing as interesting as possible. Having described the opening scene, the class then used their inference skills to make predictions about what they feel could have happened next in the story. They created freeze-frames in small groups to tell their own imaginative story ending.

In Maths, we have been working on our understanding of place value and numbers to 1000. Fortune have been using a range of manipulatives to demonstrate their work and have completed a wide range of tricky investigations.

In our topic sessions, we have started to explore This Is Me. Fortune have come up with a range of wonderful projects that we will be undertaking this year and have held some brilliant discussions all about their dreams for the future. As a class, we have also explored how people aims and dreams may change as they move through life.
