This week we have been learning...

Welcome back to term 2. We hope you had a restful break.

This week, in our writing, we have started to look at the story of 'Claude in the City'. All week we have been using expanded noun phrases within our writing to make it descriptive. We have been able to describe the main character Claude, describe an adventure he could go on and describe Maidstone.

In maths we have been learning about money. We have been able to recognise pounds and pence and can start to describe the different coins and notes, as well as beginning to write them correctly. We have also learnt how to count in pence and pounds and started to combine pounds and pence to create specific amounts of money.

This term our inquiry is all about homes and journeys. We have started this by looking at the world and locating the 7 continents and the major oceans. We have then looked at the United Kingdom in more detail. We made posters to advertise a country within the United Kingdom. We have been able to look at different homes around the world and discussed our misconceptions. In P.E we have been looking at how we travel with our bodies.
