This week we have been learning...

This week, in our writing, we have continued to look at the story of 'Claude in the City'. We have written a postcard which will be sent off addressed to the other Year 2 class describing an adventure we could of taken in Maidstone using our Expanded noun phrases we learnt last week. We have been able to create a freeze frame of a scene from the book and role played a press conference taking notes of the answer to specific question. We have broken up a newspaper and looked at the features of a newspaper and used this to help plan and write an article about the freeze frame we created.

In maths we have continued to learn about money. We have looked at creating amounts and totals using both pounds and pence. We have also compared different amounts of money and explained what is more or less and why. We have being starting to learn about change and how we get change and use change in a role play setting

This week in inquiry we have been looking at different materials that people from around the world can use in everyday life and specifically to build houses and roofs. We have made a house from clay and experimented what materials are better for the roof. We have also started to look at clothing materials to see what clothes are better for different weather conditions.


