This week we have been learning...

This week, in our writing, we have continued to read the book 'Are we there yet?'. All week we have continued our learning of similes. We have used them in our report writing about our destination and descriptive writings.

We have also written a recount, diary entry, about our visit to our art gallery with paintings from famous artist from our destinations. We have had an underwater experience and have written a recount and description using amazing adjectives and expanded noun phrases and some fantastic similes. We even got a little wet.

In maths we have started to learn about multiplication. We have recognised how to make equal groups in a range of methods and added equal groups together. We have also been able to make arrays and understand what they are. We have looked at the multiplication sign and discussed when it is used.
