

# Year 4 Ambrosia Newsletter

This week, Ambrosia class have published their retelling of a Greek myth and have produced some excellent writing! The class have asked to write their own story in the style of a Greek myth and so we have started collecting ideas - including designing our own mythical beasts. Our plan is to create an 'Ambrosia Book of Myths for our book area.

To start thinking about our characters, we have researched mythical creatures from Greek stories and have invented our own. We have drawn them in our sketch pads and have started considering how we can make a model or image of our beast using a range of media in our art lessons.

In maths, we have continued to practice short multiplication. We are now multiplying 3 digit by 1 digit numbers and applying our knowledge to solving problems. We will be moving on to division in the coming week.

Our inquiry work has focused on identifying aspects of Greek life that we still use today in science, maths, art and English. We have a lot of work to do so if you have time to do some further research at home, all help will be appreciated.
