This week we have been learning...

In our writing, we have been independently choosing how to present our research, using posters, fact files and comic strips to share information about Pompeii. We have looked at the Pixar short film 'Lava', created notes of what we saw and these helped us to rewrite the story using a class made checklist. We have been able to work with a partner helping them improve their work using our green pens. We have also written a diary entry from one of the characters perspectives.

In Maths, we have been revising the skills we have learnt so far. We have looked at addition using the 'w' method, number lines or column method and subtraction also using number lines or column method. With multiplication we have been using arrays to find our answers and division using number lines or sharing.

In our inquiry 'HOT! HOT! HOT!' We have looked at communities and how disasters such as the Great Fire of London and Pompeii changed these communities.

We have looked at the painting of the Last Supper by Leonardo Di Vinci and have used this to create our own versions of this scene.

In P.E we have learnt about blocking to protect a target and how we can move our bodies to different rhythms.
