Attendance

Car Park

Some key points that must be adhered to as we now have another 60 children:

- Please do not arrive on site before 3:15pm. Reception will be coming out at 3:30pm so if you're not collecting anyone until 3:45pm please don't arrive before then – this will allow these 60 parents to leave the site before we release the rest of the school.
- The speed limit is **5mph**.
- The car park operates a **one way system**, please abide by this.
- **In the morning, the drop-off point is only to be used accordingly.** Children need to be able to get out of the car and go straight into class. If parents wish to escort them to the class, please use a parking bay.
- At busy times people may double park, providing there is still clear access to the one-way system. Please do not park before the drop off zone, this blocks access. **Please be patient and courteous. We will always hold onto children – if you can't park, then please don't worry – we would rather you were a minute or two late than parking inconsiderately or blocking access.**
- No blocking of the zebra crossing
- Disabled bays for blue badge holders only

We are still looking at the staggered end of the day – but this needs to be taken to Governors before any changes can be put in place.
