This Week:

We have had a great week learning all about elderly people and discussing the older people in our own families.

In English, we have been practising our sentence writing by ensuring we are using a capital letter, full stop and finger spaces in every sentence we are writing.

In Maths, the children have been learning about ordering objects from biggest to smallest. They have also worked hard learning the term ordinal numbers and can recognise the position of an object up to 10!

In our Inquiry lessons, we have been exploring how objects and people age. We have looked at our teachers families and explored the features that show a person is elderly

How can you help at home?

Please continue to read with your child at least 4 times a week for 10 minutes and note down any unfamiliar words or sounds that they may have seen whilst reading. Please ensure you sign their reading record each time you read with them.

Children should have their reading record every day and put this in the box either to have their books changed or to check if they have read.

Home Learning this week is:

Spellings: do, to, today, of, said

Spelling test will be every friday and completed in the children's spelling books. The spelling books will be sent home for you to see how your child has done. However, they must be returned for the next spelling test the following friday.

The homework for the term has been set, so explore some of the activities with your child when you are ready. This is due back to school by Friday 11th October 2019.
